Show Rules & Conditions of Entry

- 1 The show will be conducted under AQHA rules. The judge's decision is final.
- 2 Youth age to be taken from 1st August. Youth classes will be combined if there are insufficient entries.
- 3 The committee reserves the right to change the order of events before or during the show. It is the responsibility of the competitor to be aware of any changes.
- 4 The committee, its affiliates and sponsors will not be held responsible for any injury incurred, damage to or loss of goods. All competitors compete at their own risk.
- 5 There will be a Disputes Committee consisting of the Show Manager, a Committee Member and one Contestant.
- 6 The SQHA Committee reserves the right to prohibit any person from showing or attending any horse in the show ring, and to remove any person or horse from the grounds without being liable for compensation
- 7 A Beginner Youth or Adult is a competitor that satisfies the three following criteria:
 - Has not won **ANY** performance event in an Open, Amateur or Youth class at any A or AA Class SQHA or equivalent show where there were three or more entrants in the class.
 - Has not won **three** times in that particular Beginner event where there were three or more competitors. After a competitor has obtained three wins, they are no longer eligible to participate in that particular Beginner class.
 - Has not won a Beginner Youth or Adult **High Point or Versatility Award**.
- 8 After a Beginner has obtained wins as detailed above, they are no longer eligible to participate in Beginner classes in subsequent years. The competitor may continue to show in Beginner classes until the end of the points' year.
- 9 Notwithstanding the above, the SQHA Committee reserves the right to use their discretion in determining the Beginner status of any competitor.
- 10 Beginner Riders can ride 'two handed' regardless of the age of the horse or the type of bit used.
- 11 Beginner Riders are not to compete on colts or stallions.
